H.O.P.E. is growing!

At the PHCG, we like to say we're HOPE dealers. It's one of our team values because it's such an important part of what we do every day. Spreading hope and being hopeful means choosing to believe that God is faithful and knowing He's not done until it's good. HOPE is also an acronym for our pregnancy and parenting educational program, Hope Offered in Pregnancy Experience. It's one of our most important programs that take expecting parents through educational topics like infant CPR, newborn care, and postpartum care. After class, we share a meal together that's been sponsored by a church or small group and then finish with a bible study. Students receive parenting gifts like diaper bags and baby bathtubs at the end of each education phase. The goal is to equip each person with the life skills, material assistance, and spiritual strength they need to confidently care for their family.

The first class in August was the largest attended class in PHCG history, twenty-two students!

And this doesn't even include our Esperanza students (HOPE in Spanish)!

In this class, moms and dads learned about prenatal and postnatal nutrition, led by our volunteers, Nancy Attaway (Board Member) and Alicia Cano, who graduated with a nutrition degree and is now a medical student at UTMB pursuing a career in pediatrics.

Students went home with a better understanding of the best foods to eat to stay healthy and even got to take home some fruits and veggies!

Hope is certainly growing here at the PHCG, and we're so thankful for YOU and your support that's helping us make a lasting generational impact!
